Equality Policy

Introduction

It is our policy that all students wear College uniform when attending College, or when participating in a College-organised event outside normal College hours.

Aims and objectives

Our policy is based on the notion that a uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the College;
- provides a feeling of community and belonging;
- is practical and smart;
- identifies the students with the College;
- is not distracting in class (as fashion clothes might be);
- makes students feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable, and good value for money, by most parents/carers;
- has been designed with health and safety in mind.

In line with our values, most of the uniform is available from high street shops. The College stocks badges, ties and blazers. Any parents/carers who wish to purchase these items should contact the College reception on 01326 572685 and ask for the PSA attached to their child's year group – this will enable a convenient time to be arranged to try on several blazers to ensure a good fit.

Uniform consists of:

- HCC Navy blue College blazer with a cloth College badge.
- HCC Clip-on tie.
- Light blue shirt (white for Years 10 & 11).
- Black trousers (these should fall freely from the knee and not cling to the lower leg. Jeans or cargo style are not permitted); OR a Black tailored skirt (tube style skirts are not permitted); OR Black tailored shorts (cargo or sport style are not permitted).
- Navy blue v-neck jumper (optional).
- Plain black socks (with no logos or markings) OR tights.
- Plain black shoes (not suede and if laced, with black laces. No logos or markings).

PE Kit:

- HCC Rugby shirt (robust material for contact sports); OR a HCC polo shirt.
- Navy blue football socks.
- Navy blue shorts; OR navy blue skort; OR navy blue or black leggings
- Trainers and football/rugby boots. (Please see Appendix for precise type of footwear).
- Towel.
- Swimming shorts or costume.

Optional Extras:

- HCC navy blue hoody or plain crew neck navy blue sweatshirt. No labels or markings.
- Navy blue or white base-layer.
- Navy blue tracksuit bottoms. No labels or markings.
- HCC navy ¼ zip sweatshirt.

Recommended:

• shin pads and gum shield.

Drama:

Students need to be either barefoot or bring soft clean shoes such as pumps, ballet/jazz shoes or soft trainers with a gripping sole to avoid slipping during practical activities. Failure to do so will result in not being able to take part in practical work. This is for their safety and the safety of others in the studio.

The Role of Parents/Carers

We ask all parents/carers who send their children to our College for their support in ensuring that their children are correctly dressed when arriving at College so that they are ready for their daily College work. Parents/carers should ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.

The College welcomes students from all backgrounds and faith communities. If there are serious reasons, for example religious objections, why parents/carers want their child to wear clothes that differ from the College uniform, we will look sympathetically at such requests. Similarly, should an item of College uniform prove problematic for a student with disabilities then parents/carers are invited to draw this to the attention of the Headteacher. The College will not treat students with disabilities unfavourably.

Any student arriving at College without the correct uniform will be:

- supplied with a temporary replacement from College
- where appropriate, a replacement may need to brought in from home
- repeated instances of not following the College uniform policy will be escalated through the college behaviour system
- repeated instances of not following the College policy will be met with sanctions as in line with the College Behaviour Policy

Piercings

Students are allowed one pair of stud earrings (to be worn in the ear lobes), <u>no-hooped earrings.</u> Students are allowed one discreet nose stud, but <u>no nose ring</u>. All piercings must be removed for PE lessons.

Jewellery

No jewellery is allowed to be worn at College, other than one pair of stud earrings, one nose stud and one wrist watch. Any other jewellery seen will be confiscated and returned at the end of that half-term. Failure to hand over such items will be escalated through the college behaviour system.

<u>Please note all students are required to remove stud earrings, watches and nose studs in order to participate in any PE lessons/sports activities</u>. Refusal to remove such items will be escalated through the college behaviour system.

Coats

Students may wear any coat. Coats may not be worn in lessons and students are expected to take them off rather than wait to be asked. Non-uniform hoodies may not be worn as coats over College uniform.

Makeup

Students are allowed to wear makeup but it must be subtle. Anyone wearing very bold makeup will be asked to remove it. False nails are not permitted to be worn to College.

Hair styles

Students are allowed hair styles that are reasonable. There should be no obvious hair dye, designs shaved into the hair, or closely shaved heads. There should be no extreme hair styles.

Support

We are an inclusive College and are happy to support parents/carers if there is an issue with purchasing College uniform. If this is the case, please contact your child's PSA for a confidential discussion.

In this regard, second hand uniform is also available and we would ask that any leavers donate any unneeded uniform to the College for future year groups.

Parents/carers can contact the College SENCO for support should their child have any sensory needs.
