Key Stage 4 Options Evening – Wednesday 02 February 2022 - 5.00pm - 7.00pm

Your child will soon be making some very important choices regarding what they will study in KS4 at Helston Community College. Our curriculum offers a wide range of level 2 (GCSE or equivalent) courses, and whilst some students will have a very clear idea what they wish to study, others may need more support and guidance. We hope that the process we have put in place will allow your child to make the best possible choices for their future.

I would like to invite you to our Key Stage 4 Options Evening which will be taking place on Wednesday 02 February 2022, between 5.00pm and 7.00pm, on our North Site campus.

During the evening, I will lead talks in the North Site Main Hall at 5.00pm and 6.00pm, outlining the Key Stage 4 Curriculum structure. The Options Online process will be explained in detail, alongside the range of courses on offer.

Subject specific Key Stage 4 information will be provided between 5.00pm and 7.00pm. This will be an opportunity to find out more about the courses on offer next year. Teachers will be available to answer any questions, so you and your child can make informed decisions.

In addition to the talks in the North Site Main Hall, I will be available, along with senior staff, to answer questions and to give further advice.

You will shortly receive a copy of the Key Stage 4 Options Booklet via email, to help you to prepare for the options process. This will also be available to view on the College website. The Options Booklet will contain all the information you require to access the online content, including the access codes. The Google Classrooms are interactive and therefore you can submit any questions direct to subject teachers, who should respond at their earliest convenience.
