Transition Timeline

Step 1	Wednesday 25 September 2024 Community Open Evening This event will give you and your child the opportunity to explore the campus, meet the staff and find out more about the life and work of Helston Community College.
Step 2	Thursday 31 October 2024 Deadline for applying for a secondary school place By this deadline you need to make an application to Cornwall Council School Admissions to apply for your child's secondary school place.
Step 3	Monday 3rd March 2025 Secondary School places announced On this date secondary school places will be announced by Cornwall Council School Admissions. There will be a short grace period while School Admissions process late applications. We expect to receive the official intake list by the end of March.
Step 4	March 2025 Primary Visits During March and April, Mr Dudley, Mrs Harris, Year 7 PSA and Year 7 Students will visit local feeder primary schools either in person or virtually. These visits will give your child the opportunity to meet with our staff in a familiar environment, where they can ask any questions they may have about life at Helston Community College. During these visits, staff will also have a handover meeting with your child's teacher to ensure all information is passed on — this includes suggested tutor groupings.
Step 5	Friday 25 April 2025 Enrolment Paperwork This is the deadline for submitting your child's Enrolment Form. This will be sent shortly.

	At the peak of our transition process is the two-day visit to the College. During this visit, the students will meet their peers whilst taking part in subject-based activities. Students will also be able to experience lunch in the South Site Canteen and have a tour of the campus.

	Parents/carers will be invited to attend one of our New Parents' Information Evenings which take place on the evenings of the two transition days. During the evenings, there will be a key		
	note address by the Headteacher, followed by the opportunity to interact with your child's		
	Tutor.		
Step 8	July 2025 Getting ready for your child's first day		
	At the end of July, you will receive a letter from the College detailing arrangements for the first		
	day of term.		
	On your child's first day they will be provided with a 'New Starter Pack' which will include a copy		
	of their timetable, a map of the campus, computer and canteen logons, and all other relevant information.

The Enrolment Form will shortly be uploaded to Year 6 Transition on the College website. It is vital this form is completed in order to process your child's application.
