Thank you for supporting your children through this difficult time. It is not easy having to juggle home learning alongside so many other personal and potential challenges, and the encouragement you give them to keep going is so important.

Approximately 120 students from Years 7, 8 and 9 shared examples of their best work with me last week and it took quite some time to reply to all of them, but it was lovely to be able to interact directly. We had a virtual prize draw on Tuesday and 8 gift vouchers were awarded. This week it is the turn of Years 10 and 11, so I am expecting great things! 












Year 9 - the Year 9 Virtual Options Evening will take place via Google Classrooms and Google Meets on Wednesday 10 February 2021.
