## New GCSEs

## In September 2017 new GCSEs were introduced.

These GCSEs are more demanding and require higher levels of literacy and numeracy to access the top grades.

## Assessment

All assessment to take place at the end of a course and take the form of examinations in most subjects. Only Maths and Science and have tiers.
