Helston Community College Music Centre offers 30 and 20 minute instrumental and singing lessons to students between the hours of 8.40am and 6.30pm Monday – Friday (term time only). We have an excellent team of Music teachers who are able to prepare your child for Trinity College and / or Rock School grade exams.

Prices Per Term (10 lessons)

Due to the current Covid-19 restrictions, lessons during the autumn term and until further notice will only be available on a one to one basis (single lessons). We have also had to adjust lesson length so only 20 or 30 minute lessons will be available.

Please note that as soon as we are safely able to do so we will be offering 30 minute lessons, as before, in groups of two and three at rates of £90 for groups of two and £110 for groups of three.

Children of serving Royal Navy families receive £50 per term discount for one instrument, all other instrument lessons are standard price.

Children in receipt of free school meals also receive £50 per term discount for one instrument.

Lessons must be paid for in advance each term.

Once I am in receipt of your child's application, I will email you an invoice. Invoices can be paid via Parent Pay or cheque payable to **Southerly Point Co-operative MAT**. For new students, Parent Pay accounts will be set up in September 2020.

Missed Lessons

It is the student's responsibility to give the Music Department a week notice if a lesson is going to be missed due to a school trip or exam. The Music team will then reschedule this lesson. Please note lessons take place as normal on PSHE days. Lessons missed due to illness unfortunately cannot be rescheduled. A half term's notice must be given if you wish to cease having lessons.

Please note that during Covid-19 restrictions all BRASS, WOODWIND and SINGING lessons will take place in a large ventilated room with at least 5m distancing. All other instrumental lessons will have 2m distancing. Students will be expected to use the sanitizing station provided on entry to the lesson.
