**Year 7 Spanish Set Changes**

This year, all Year 7 Spanish students have their lessons at the same time within their respective populations. As a result, we are now able to move students between their classes. We have taken into account the results of any tests from last term, including short vocabulary and grammar ones as well as participation in lesson and attendance.
