Dear Parent/Carer

Your son/daughter has shown interest in joining a three day inter-departmental Key Stage 4 trip to Disneyland Paris' Business and Computing Live! from 1<sup>st</sup> March – 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2020. The trip includes:

- Return rail transfers to St Pancras
- Return Eurostar transfer to Disneyland Paris
- 2 nights' accommodation in Hotel Cheyenne, located within the Disneyland resort

As well as the all-important visit to the rides and resort of Disneyland Paris, the students will attend their chosen subject specific (Business or Computing) conference. Expert speaker presentations aim to bring key curriculum topics to life and provide students with access to information and case studies that they can't find in a text book. Students are given a workbook with challenges to complete in the Parks, making the event an immersive educational experience aimed at seeing Business and Computing in action. There will also be the opportunity for students to ask questions of the industry practitioners and learn about careers associated with the subject during the interactive question and answer sessions.

Helston Community College trips are popular, so the behaviour of students will be a factor considered when issuing places for the trip and will be monitored prior to the trip. However, in order to secure the hotel rooms before the end of July, **a deposit of £20 is required by 19<sup>th</sup> July via ParentPay**. The remaining balance of £450 can be paid by instalments, to be paid by 15<sup>th</sup> November 2019. Fund raising events may also be held in the autumn term by the students to offset costs.

Please complete and return the reply slip to Mrs Cavender or Mr Welsh as soon as possible, students will be notified when we return in the Autumn term if they have been offered a place on the trip.
