Dear Parents and Carers

We continue to be fortunate in having no Covid-19 cases amongst students and staff. However, to further increase the safety of our staff and students, we intend to follow the latest local Public Health recommendations and ask students to wear a face covering at certain times when in College.

This decision has not been taken lightly and is, as I am sure you are aware, due to the rise of Covid-19 cases within Cornwall and our local community, mainly due to the highly transmissible new Delta variant of Covid-19.

Please can we ask, with effect from **Monday 21 June 2021**, that all students attend College wearing a face covering (unless they are exempt). Students should wear a face covering when moving around the school in all corridors and communal areas. They are not required to wear a face covering whilst they are seated in the classroom, or when sat in the designated eating areas, unless of course they wish to do so.

We will of course continue to keep this under review and let you know should there be any changes. Hopefully, this early action, will avoid any bubble closures for the rest of the academic year.

Whilst writing, due to some changes in testing and isolation we have updated our Covid-19 FAQ, which is attached for ease of reference. This has also been published on our website in the "News" section should you wish to refer to it at any time.

Thank you for your continued support in helping keep our staff, students and our local community safe.
