Transition Timeline

We understand that the move from primary to secondary education can seem a daunting transition, and that the challenges presented by Coronavirus and home learning have increased anxiety. In response, we are committed to making this process as smooth as possible for our students. We hope this timeline will explain this year's transition process to ensure the best possible outcome for your child.

Saturday 31st October 2020 | Deadline for applying for a secondary school place

Back in the autumn term you should have made an application to Cornwall Council School Admissions to apply for your child's secondary school place. Monday 1st March 2021 | Secondary School places announced

Secondary school places were confirmed by School Admissions. They are currently still processing late admissions and we expect to receive the official intake list by the end of April 2021.

Monday 29th March 2021 | New Transition Website Launches

We have created a new transition website which will be your first port of call throughout this process, it contains:

May—June 2021 | Visiting our feeder primary schools

Tuesday 29th June 2021 | Transition Day 1 (All Year 6 students)

Wednesday 30th June 2021 | Transition Day 2 (All Year 6 students)

At the peak of our transition process is the two-day visit to HCC. If pandemic restrictions allow, these visits are planned to take place on Tuesday 29th and Wednesday 30th June 2021. During this two-day visit, the students will meet their peers, tutor and tutor group, whilst taking part in subject-based activities. Students will also be able to experience lunch in the South Site Canteen. Towards the end of the day, students will take part in a year group bubble activity, where we hope to inspire team spirit and a sense of community.
